**Sikkim Viklang Sahayata Samiti (Sikkim Branch)**

Sikkim Vikalang Sahayata Samiti is a Non-Governmental Organization established during 1999 and is registered with Government of Sikkim, Registered. No. 11/68/Not. No.2602/AH/29.1.2001. Since inception the Organization has been working selflessly for the welfare of physically challenged persons of Sikkim. And for the welfare of the marginalized sections of society especially the disabled persons of the state. The organization undertook many welfare activities during the financial year 2011 – 2012, as done so in the past years with the help of well wishers of the organization, volunteers and Sikkim Government Departments like Social Justice Empowerment & Welfare, Capacity Building, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry, Human Resource Dev Deptt, Rural Management Dev Dept, Information Technology Deptt and Private Sector Companies like NHPC, LANCO etc. The welfare activities undertaken by the organization are given in detail as follows.

- **Beautician Course** : From 10<sup>th</sup> May 2011, beautician training course was given to 10 disabled girls in the office of Sikkim Viklang Sahayata Samiti, 'Zero Point', Gangtok, for a period of one year. Till date 10 trainees have undergone this training programme and two of them have been employed in SVSS Beauty Parlour. The details are as follows.

### Various Disability Identification Camps participated by SVSS

- Mr R.B.Ghimiray (Senior Technician) and Miss Droupadi Ghimiray, President and Computer trainees attended Disability Identification Camp for various disabilities organized by the District Collector, East and SSA, Human Resource Development Department, on **20<sup>th</sup> May 2011 at Rongli.**

The following types of disabilities were registered & identified:-

1. Mental Retardation
2. Cleft Lip & Cleft Palate
3. Spastic
4. Burn cases
5. Orthopedic

- **On 25<sup>th</sup> May 2011, Disability Identification Camp** was organized by East District Collector, East & SSA and it was attended by disabled trainees of SVSS at Pakyong.



- On 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> June 2011 Bharat Nirman ( Public Information and press Information Bureau, Ministry of Broadcasting & Press Information Bureau, Government of India, organized a Bharat Nirman Public Information Campaign at Yangyang, South Sikkim. It was attended by the officer bearers and disabled members of SVSS.

- **On July & August 2011**

Survey Camp was organized by SVSS for cleft Lip & Cleft palate in the four Districts of Sikkim and identified and collected 56 cases of Cleft Lip Cleft palate & 25 Burn Cases.

- **On 15-22 Sept. 2011** Smile Train of Agra conducted reconstructive surgery for Cleft Lip & Palate at the premises of Central Referral Hospital Tadong. The Team of Doctors from Agra namely **Dr. Satya Saraswat & Dr. Mahajan** and 3 Technicians performed the Surgery. The Surgery was sponsored by Smile Train and the Health Care, Human Services Dept, Government of Sikkim provided Rs. 50000/- for boarding and lodging and local transportation for patients and Doctors & teams visiting Agra. Hon'ble Minister H.R.D.D. Government of Sikkim Shri N.K. Pradhan inaugurated the Camp along with Dr K. Bhandari Secretary Health and Family Welfare, Government of Sikkim as Guest of Honor and Superintendent Central



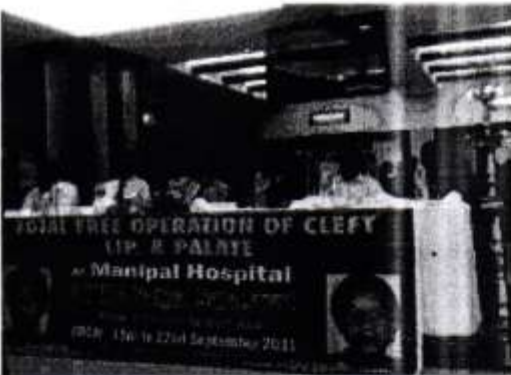
Referral Hospital (C.R.H.) and Seniors Doctors of Sikkim Manipal Hospital Institute of Medical Science along with all Members of Sikkim Viklang Samiti and Dr. Bela Cintury, Sikkim State Council for Child Welfare were present. Though 56 nos. of Patients were identified for operation only **23 persons were operated** as patients were frightened and left the Hospital following massive Earth Quake that struck on 18<sup>th</sup> Sep 2011. The Doctors continued to operate a 7 years old child Norbu Sherpa of West Sikkim even when Earth Quake struck.

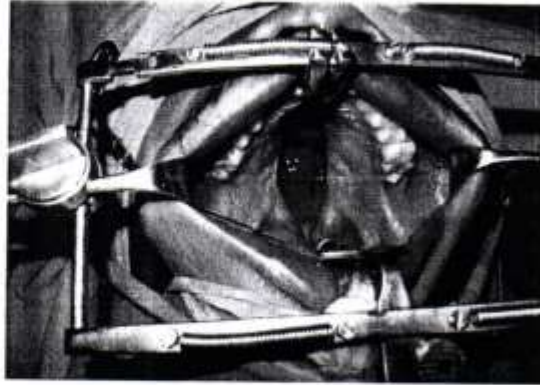

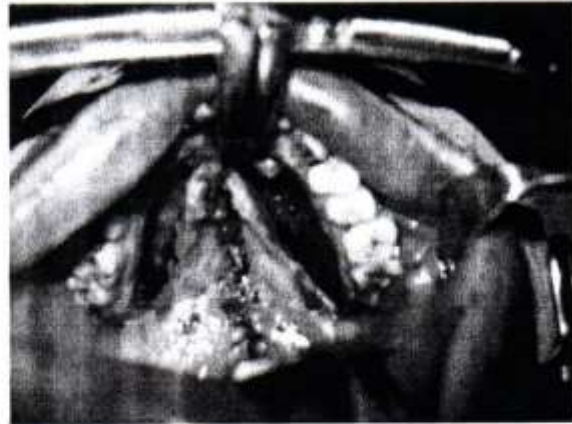

- On 9<sup>th</sup> JAN.2012 11 patients were again sent to **Saraswat Hospital at Agra**, 8 nos. of patients were sponsored by Health Department, Government of Sikkim and 3 **patients** were sponsored by N.H.P.C. Stage-V. All those patients were suffering from various degree of burn. They are accompanied by **Mrs. Lalita Pradhan**, a member of S.V.S.S.



- On 19<sup>th</sup> January 2012 Annual General meeting of Sikkim Viklang Sahayata Samiti was held at the chamber of Shri **K.T.Gyaltzen, Hon'ble Speaker** where **upcoming activities** were discussed and accordingly decisions were taken for the smooth running of the activities of SVSS.





- On 24<sup>th</sup> Jan 2012, 9 (nine) patients were taken to Agra for undergoing corrective surgeries. Out of the 9 patients, 2 were burn cases , 1 was tongue tight and 1 was a spastic patient who were all operated at Dr. Satya Saraswat Hospital, Agra and they were escorted by **President of S.V.S.S, Miss Droupadi Ghimiray**. The expense was borne by NHPC-(V) Teesta and Health Care, Human Services & Family Welfare, Government of Sikkim.





- **13<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> Feb 2012** Ministry of Information & Broadcasting Bureau,, Government of India, Bharat Nirman Public Information, organized a Flagship Programme at Dentam, West Sikkim and it was participated by **Mr. Khilan Tamang, Technician, SVSS.**



- **On 12<sup>th</sup> March 2012** the SVSS staff Ms. Shanti Ghimiray, Ms. Seema Ghimiray and Mr. Nima Tamang attended a training programme on strengthening and updating professional skills of Services Providers working in the field of disability. The training programme was conducted by Health Care, Human Services & Family Welfare, and Government of Sikkim.



- To empower the disabled persons by providing training is one of the main objectives of S.V.S.S. Accordingly **Computer Education for a period of two years is being provided to 30 disabled persons of the state which is sponsored by ERNET, Government of India and Capacity Building, Government of Sikkim.** And to enhance their academic qualification to make them more employable, **Five Ways and Rotary Club of Sikkim are providing free tuitions to these 15 disabled students of SVSS to enable them to appear for class X and XII exams through the open school.**

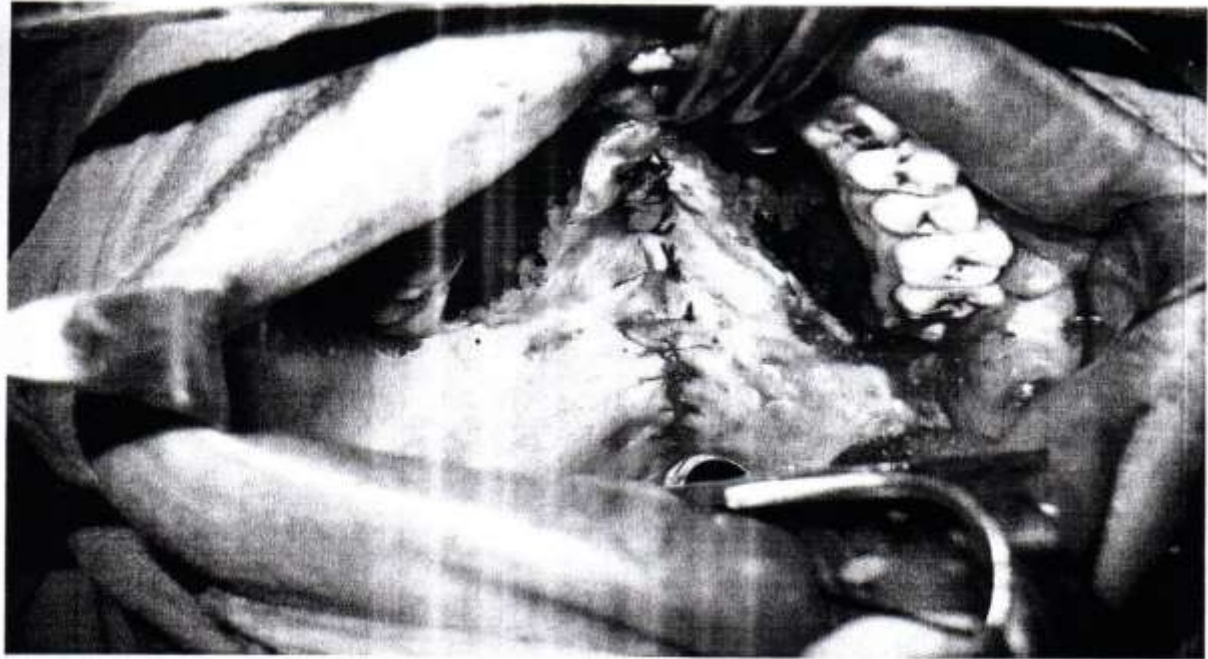

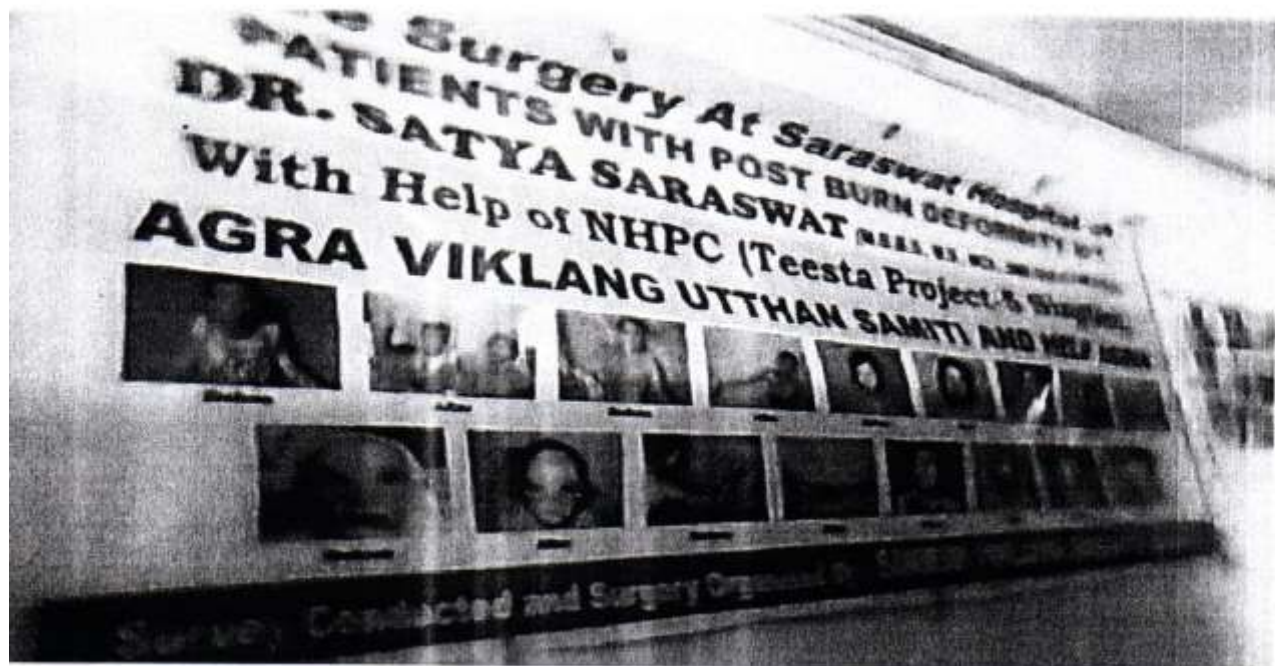
