Details of ACTIVITIES done by the Sikkim Viklang Sahayata Samiti

during 2014-15

1. In the month of April 2014, SVSS have constructed toilet in the Rehabilitation Center for Differently Abled at, Reshap, Tokal Bermiok, South Sikkim. The project was sponsored by the RMDD, Govt. of Sikkim of 1 Lakh and 80 Thousand Rupees.



2. On 29th July 2014, SVSS started Poultry farm at Namphing, Reship Tokal.



3. In the month of September 2014, Dr. R. S. Parekh Foundation and Research Center, Agra has donated 6.30 lakhs rupees to purchase a vehicle. The Vehicle is now in use for the benefit of differently abled persons.



4. On the occasion of World Disable Day (3rd December 2014), SVSS had begun a Khada making unit at Namphing, Reshap, Tokal Bermiok, South Sikkim which was inaugurated by the Honorable Governor of Sikkim Shri Srinivas Patil. The Unit has been started with 20 disabled persons. The Capacity Building, Govt. of Sikkim has sanctioned 4.5 lakh rupees for Khada making project.



- Three persons named Suraj Kumar Chettri, Ashok been sent to Streifeneder, Gurgaon for the fitment of Below Elbow Myo Electric Hand sponsored by the Health Department of Sikkim of Rs. 6 lakhs on 20/12/2014 and returned on 24/01/2015 escorted by Ran Bahadur Ghimiray, senior technician of SVSS.

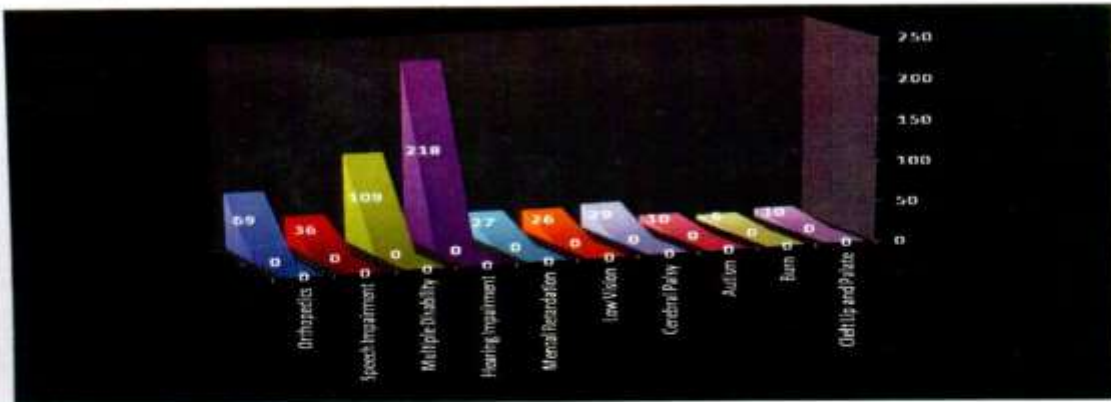

- ✓ 30 students have been selected for vocational training.



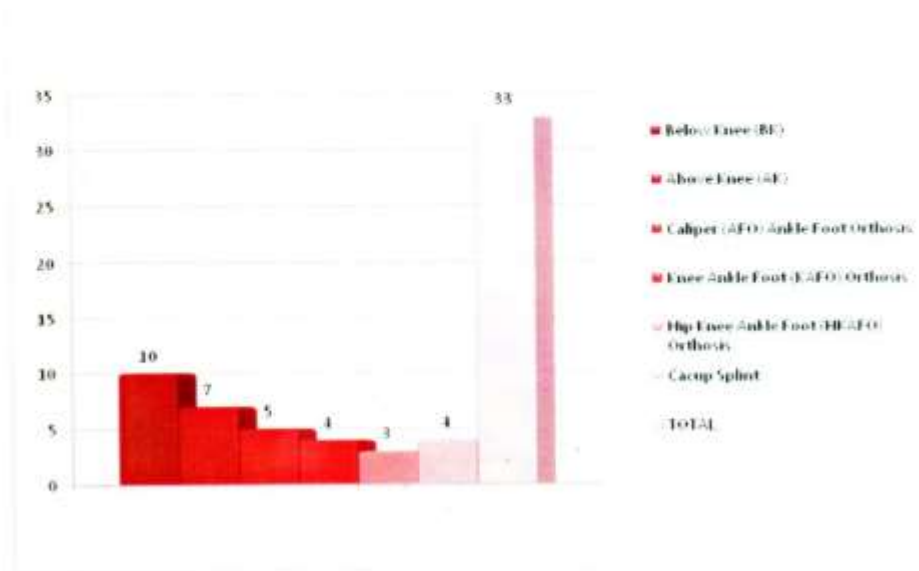
