Introduction

SIKKIM VIKLANG (DIVYANG) SAHAYATA SAMITI is a Non-Governmental Organization formed in the year 1999 and formally registered on 29.01.2001 by Law Department, Government of Sikkim vide sl. No. 1168 Vol. No I in accordance with the notification No. 2602 A/H dated 25.03.1960. Since the inception, SDSS has been working selflessly for the welfare of the Divyang People in the State of Sikkim. We provide Artificial Limbs, Wheel Chairs and Crutches for which we have trained technicians. We conduct Skill Development Training for their livelihood (like Computer Training, Khada Making, Beautician Training, Bamboo Crafts etc) in collaboration with Government and other NGO's of India.

We also do Cleft Palate Surgeries yearly with the help of Dr. Satya Saraswat (Plastic & Cosmetic Surgeon of Saraswat Hospital. Agra) supported by local Doctors and Staff of Sikkim Health Department.

We have also started the construction of 'Rehabilitation Centre' for the Divyang People at Reshap, Tokal Bermiok, South Sikkim for which we are raising funds and we hope to complete the construction soon for which we need support from one and all.

SIKKIM VIKLANG (DIVYANG) SAHAYATA SAMITI is also granted registration u/s 12AA with sub section (a) of 12A of the Income Tax Act 1961 with effect from 01.04.2012 and is also qualified for deduction u/s 80G(5)(vi) of the Income Tax Act 1961.

Lastly, nothing is possible without the help from the Government and our Well Wishers (like Hon'ble Governor of Sikkim Shri. Shriniwas Patil, various Esteemed Government Departments of the Sikkim, Private Companies etc.)

ADAPT

This year SIKKIM VIKLANG (DIVYANG) SAHAYATA SAMITI sponsored one trainee Miss Sarosoti Ghimiray to undergo training in ADAPT. Last year SIKKIM VIKLANG (DIVYANG) SAHAYATA SAMITI sent two candidates Miss Shanti Ghimiray and Miss Ambika Chettri who had successfully completed their training and working in their native place with HRDD, Govt. of Sikkim.

ADAPT (formerly, the Spastics Society of India) set up by Dr. Mithu Alur has been conducting, in collaboration with the Women's Council UK, a six month course entitled "Community Initiatives in Inclusion" for the Asia Pacific Region for over 16 years. This is a course for Master Trainers and Planners of inclusive community disability services in the Asia Pacific Region sponsored by the Women's Council, U.K and ADAPT.

The course aims to prepare participants to be management personnel, able to run, plan, and to train others to run, community disability services, within an inclusive framework.

The course content includes modules on Disability, Policy, Inclusion and Community. The course is conducted in two phases. The first 14 weeks consists of taught sessions, practical work and field work in Mumbai, India and its environs. The last three months is the implementation phase in the participants' own places of work.

250 participants from 19 Asian Countries like Bangladesh, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Jordan, Malaysia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, Tonga and Vietnam have completed this course to date.

CLEFT LIP/PALATE SURGERIES

About 11 Cleft Palate & Lip patients were sent to Agra on 25th March 2018 who was selected on the screening camp held on 8th December 2017 to get further treatment. The patients were escorted by Mrs. Purnima Sharma and Shanti Ghimiray After successful operation, this group of 11 people returned to Sikkim on 3rd April 2018.
